Infertility

One married couple in six confronts infertility, a condition clinically defined as the inability to conceive a pregnancy after one year of unprotected intercourse. However, sooner consultation is appropriate in some cases.

Candidates for earlier assessment include:

Women age 35 or over having attempted pregnancy over a 6-month time period.

Women experiencing menstrual intervals of less than 3 weeks or longer than 2 months apart.

Women having experienced 2 or more miscarriages;

Couples with medical conditions associated with compromised fertility, contraindication to pregnancy, and/or genetic characteristics affecting potential offspring.

Treatment Options

Fortunately, advances in reproductive research and technology offer many encouraging treatment options for infertile couples wishing to start or enlarge their families. Some of these alternatives alone may be successful, while others may be combined to offer the most effective treatment:

Laboratory Services

Reproductive Laboratory Services is part of RRC and provides services in-house specific to fertility testing. This ensures the consistent, high-quality results required by the physicians here at RRC. Services performed in our laboratory include semen analysis, antisperm antibody testing, semen processing for intrauterine insemination, cryopreservation of sperm and embryos, and same-day results for many hormonal assays.
